Assistant Professor – Applied Microeconomics

The Department of Economics at the University of Toronto Mississauga campus invites applications for one tenure-stream appointment in Applied Microeconomics at the rank of Assistant Professor. The appointment will be effective July 1, 2017.

The successful candidate must demonstrate excellence in research and teaching in the field of Applied Microeconomics, and have earned a Ph.D. degree in Economics or equivalent by the time of appointment or soon thereafter. She or he will be expected to conduct innovative research at the highest international level, and to establish an outstanding, externally funded research program. The positions come with undergraduate and graduate teaching responsibilities, including courses and PhD supervision in the broadly defined field of Applied Microeconomics.

Candidates must provide evidence of excellence in research of the highest international calibre, demonstrated by an innovative job market paper with a significant contribution to the literature and strong recommendations by referees. Further support can be provided by high quality working papers, presentations at significant conferences, accolades, or awards. Excellence in teaching can be demonstrated by teaching accomplishments highlighted as part of the application, strong endorsements from referees, and evidence of strong communication and expository skills. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
