

Microeconomic Theory – Assistant Professor

The Department of Economics in the Faculty of Arts and Science at the University of Toronto, St. George Campus invites applications for one full-time tenure stream appointment in Microeconomics Theory at the rank of Assistant Professor. The appointment will commence on July 1, 2019, or shortly thereafter.

Applicants must have earned a Ph.D. degree in Economics or related area by the time of appointment, or shortly thereafter, with a demonstrated record of excellence in research and teaching in Microeconomic Theory. We seek candidates whose research and teaching interests complement and strengthen our existing [departmental strengths](#). The successful candidate will be expected to conduct innovative and independent research at the highest international level, and to establish and outstanding, competitive, externally funded research program. The position comes with undergraduate and graduate teaching responsibilities.

Candidates must provide evidence of excellence in research of the highest international caliber, demonstrated by an innovative job market paper with a significant contribution to the literature and strong recommendations by referees of high standing. Further support can be provided by high quality working papers, publications in top-ranked and field relevant journals or forthcoming publications meeting high international standards, presentations at significant conferences, accolades, or awards.

Excellence in teaching can be demonstrated through teaching accomplishments, strong letters of references and a statement of teaching philosophy submitted as part of the application. Other supporting evidence can include teaching evaluations or performance as a teaching assistant, experience leading successful workshops or seminars, student mentorship, or excellent conference presentations or posters.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

A completed application will include a curriculum vitae, a job market paper, up to three working papers, a teaching dossier (to include a statement of teaching philosophy and other evidence of teaching excellence listed above, as available), and three letters of reference (on letterhead and signed) to be uploaded directly by referees.
