John August List is The Homer J. Livingston Professor in Economics at the University of Chicago and is one of the pioneers and prime promoters of using field experiments in economics. The data that Professor List has collected for his field experiments has provided insights to a range of economic phenomena, including pricing behavior, discrimination in the marketplace, the valuation of non-marketed goods and services, public goods provisioning, behavioral anomalies, charitable giving, auction theory, and the role of the market in the development of rationality.
