REVERBERATORY FURNACE -

- (1) A furnace or kiln in which the material under treatment is heated indirectly by means of a flame deflected downward from the roof. (*The American Heritage Dictionary*, 2000).
- (2) Of a furnace, kiln, etc.: So constructed that the flame is forced back upon the substance exposed to it. (Oxford English Dictionary Online).
